

The Matilda Brown Ensemble

The Matilda Brown Ensemble is an eclectic instrumental ensemble, crossing the classical, jazz, and Scottish music scenes, founded by award-winning composer, [Matilda Brown](#) in 2009. The ensemble performs music written by Matilda inspired by her adventures and solo walks across Scotland's mountainous landscapes and wilderness.

The ensemble has performed at the Dundee Mountain Film Festival, MacPhail Centre in Ullapool, Cove Park, Sound Festival, and at the Edinburgh Fringe. Each concert brings a new musical tale to audiences, each one grounded in the physical experience of the wilderness – the places, memories and thoughts from a person walking alone, and of those whom Matilda meets on the way. The Matilda Brown Ensemble and photographer, Nick Rawle, have formed a strong partnership with Nick's photographs accompanying performances and inspiring Matilda's composition process.

The line-up changes throughout the year and currently includes: Matilda Brown – vocals, guitar, keyboard and computer; Graeme Stephen - jazz guitar; Julie Aitken – flute; Ruth Rowlands – cello; Davide Rinaldi – drums; and Mairearad Green - accordion.
